Refund Policy - for Recreation & Team Sports

A Refund for Team Sports Registrations will be allowed prior to the registration deadline. The amount refunded will be the total fee received less a \$10.00 refund processing fee. After the Registration Period has ended, refunds will not be made.

Coach and Volunteer Application

Every coach and volunteer will apply annually prior to working with a Hope Youth Team. A background check is also included. This policy is across all Hope Ministries working with infants through high school children.
