READ 2 Corinthians 5:1 – 10

- How does Paul’s “home” affect his daily living?
- What is this “heavenly dwelling” like?
- How can knowing the location of your ultimate “home” affect your attitude toward aging?
- How can it encourage you to be more hospitable to others now?
- What do you plan to do differently this Christmas season in light of your ultimate “home?”
