<b>Anger</b>	A gentle answer turns away anger, but a sharp word causes anger. Proverbs 15:1
<b>Comfort</b>	Give all your worries to Him because he cares for you. 1 Peter 5:7
<b>Courage</b>	We can come to God without fear because we have put our trust in Christ. Ephesians 3:12
<b>Eternity</b>	This is the word He spoke; God gave us life that lasts forever, and this life is in His Son. 1 John 5:11
<b>Faith</b>	You must have faith as you ask Him. You must not doubt. Anyone who doubts is like a wave which is pushed around by the sea. James 1:6
<b>Forgiveness</b>	Try to understand other people. Forgive each other. If you have something against someone, forgive him. That is the way the Lord forgave you. Colossians 3:13
<b>Hope</b>	Our hope comes from God. May He fill you with joy and peace because of your trust in Him. May your hope grow stronger by the power of the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:13
<b>Humility</b>	"Whoever is without pride as this little child is the greatest in the holy nation of heaven." Matthew 18:4
<b>Leadership</b>	Keep a careful watch over yourselves and over the church. The Holy Spirit has made you its leaders. Feed and care for the church of God. He bought it with His own blood. Acts 20:28
<b>Mercy</b>	But You are a forgiving god. You are kind and loving, slow to anger, and full of loving-kindness. Nehemiah 9:17
<b>Obedience</b>	"Those who hear the Word of God and obey it are happy." Luke 11:28
<b>Patience</b>	Do not let yourselves get tired of doing good. If we do not give up, we will get what is coming to us at the right time. Galatians 6:9
<b>Peace</b>	Lying is in the heart of those who plan what is bad, but those who plan peace have joy.
<b>Pride</b>	If anyone wants to be proud, he should be proud of what the Lord has done. It is not what a man thinks and says of himself that is important. It is what God thinks of him. Galatians 6:3
<b>Salvation</b>	Christ never sinned but God has put our sin on Him. Then we are made right with God because of what Christ has done for us. 2 Corinthians 5:21
<b>Sincerity</b>	May God give loving-favor to all who love our Lord Jesus Christ with a love that never gets weak. Ephesians 6:24
<b>Strength</b>	My body and my heart may grow weak, but God is the strength of my heart and all I need forever. Psalm 73:26
<b>Temptation</b>	When you are tempted to do wrong, do not say, "God is tempting me." God cannot be tempted. He will never tempt anyone. James 1:13
<b>Truth</b>	The Law was given through Moses, but loving-favor and truth came through Jesus Christ. John 1:17
<b>Wisdom</b>	The one who is easy to fool believes everything, but the wise man looks where he goes. Proverbs 14:15
